

Year 5 and Year 6 Excursion to Berry Sport & Recreation Centre Monday 9th October to Friday 13th October 2023 (inclusive)

Dear Parent/Caregiver,

The major excursion for Years 5 & 6 this year will be 5 days at the Berry Sport & Recreation Centre. The Sport & Recreation Centre provides a wide range of activities which include instruction and experience in archery, initiative tasks, canoeing, orienteering, bush walking, rock wall, ropes course and night activities. Children will depart from the school at 9.00am on Monday 9th October and return by 3.00pm on Friday 13th October 2023.

The cost of the excursion is \$565.00 per student. We acknowledge that many families are still recovering financially from COVID restrictions and as such the school will this year be subsidising \$50.00 per student for this excursion. The cost of the excursion will therefore be **\$515.00 per student**.

The cost covers travel to and from Berry by seat belted bus, all activities, all meals including snacks and supper, accommodation for 5 days and supervision whilst we are there. The camp enables students to experience activities they may not otherwise have an opportunity to engage in, as well as, providing them with vital opportunities for personal growth and development.

Parents may like to pay in installments to make payment easier. As always, early payment is greatly appreciated. Please note, final payment is due by the 15th September 2023.

A packing list and an additional medical note as required by Berry Sport & Recreation Centre will be sent home closer to the excursion date. The accompanying staff members will be Ms Dell, Mrs Matthews, Miss Burns, Miss Griffiths and Mr Pidgeon.

The excursion will involve the following water or swimming activities: canoeing and raft building. These activities will take place at Berry Sport and Recreation Centre.

Unfortunately, COVID restrictions have interrupted our ability to attend this excursion in recent years. Historically, this has been a biennial event at St Georges Basin Public School and has proved to be an enjoyable and worthwhile experience. We are so excited to be able to once again offer this opportunity for our Stage 3 students.

If you would like your child to participate in this excursion please complete the attached notes, enclose a **\$50.00 non-refundable deposit** and return to school by Friday 21st July 2023.


